## **USA Wildwater Eastern Team Trials 2015**

## December 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, Susquehanna River, Falmouth, PA

2016 Wildwater Eastern Team Trials will consist of 2 races; 1 Classic (1 run) and 1 Sprint Race (2 runs). Qualifying participants will be eligible to compete at the Wildwater World Championships in Banja Luka in June, 2016. Team members will also be able to compete at Wildwater World Cup races in Slovenia (Cjelje) and France (Pau).

The Classic Course will be held at 2pm on Saturday December 5<sup>th</sup> 2-15, which should provide sufficient time for practice runs for those coming into town on the day. The course will run from the Conewago bridge on the Eastern shore to the Kings Road. The course can vary significantly depending upon flow, and may be changed if conditions dictate. Be prepared for large uneven waves and large unpredictable boils.

The Sprint runs will be held starting at 10am on Sunday December 6<sup>th</sup> 2015 over a short course within the Classic course (depending on conditions).

Rescue will be provided but the Susquehanna is a very high flow wide river so be advised that if you swim out of your boat you may be in the water for some time. Please dress accordingly.

Parking at the put-in is VERY limited and we hope to arrange shuttles from the takeout to avoid any issues. This is the lower bridge to the Three Mile Island Nuclear Power Plant so security is VERY tight and we cannot block the road at any time.

Registration is \$20 for each event (Sprint and Classic), and all participants must sign the USACK waiver. Entry forms are attached below the USACK waiver.

Payment for entry is possible on the day, as long as all transactions are completed by 10am. Entries after 10am will NOT be permitted.

Elizabethtown and Middletown PA are the closest towns to the race course that offer lodging and restaurants. Ample floor space is available at the race organizer's house, although parking will be limited. Local camping can be arranged, and the Holiday Inn Express in Elizabethtown is the closest decent hotel.
